How the Scoring System Works

When there are two classes of competitors, effectively two separate events are run. With a class of five competitors the lowest points allocation is 84 points and with a class of 15 competitors, the lowest points allocation is 56 points.

Scores are calculated by allocating the lowest time finisher 100 points (less any penalties), second lowest time finisher achieves 95 points (less any penalties) and so-on with the points difference diminishing further down the time order.

Therefore, in order to achieve an overall result, all competitors are put in the same class and the results are completely recalculated.
